THE ROLE

- » Overseeing the church programme, ensuring good and regular communication with the church family
- » Ensuring and overseeing the completion of basic admin tasks done by the vicar and others, to free up time for pastoral ministry.
- » Working with our Operations Coordinator to ensure the smooth running of our Operations ministries.

Initially we are looking for the applicant to work 12 hours per week, with the possibility of increasing these hours to 16 hours per week, depending on the person and work load.

THE APPLICANT

We are looking for someone who first of all is seeking to walk daily following Christ, loving him and being changed by him. The successful candidate will be humble, teachable and eager to serve.

It is expected that the Ministry Coordinator will:

- » be gifted organisationally
- » have good communication skills and be pastorally sensitive when dealing with others.
- » be excellent at personal time management.
- » be someone who is can follow instructions well and also self-start, using their own initiative to take projects forward.

Ideally the successful applicant will also be a member of St Simon's.

It is a genuine occupational requirement that the post-holder is a Christian who is aligned with the Church of England Evangelical Council basis of faith.
